- 2. Sushi





Different Kinds of Tuna

- The traditional canned tuna is typically a lighter meat or white meat tuna, this usually comes from skipjack and yellowfin
- Sushi tuna is a dark meat tuna and comes from bluefin
- Tuna are rather large fish yellowfin can reach around 400 lbs and bluefin

can reach weights over 900 lbs






Where Does The Tuna Come From?

- All of the traditional canned tuna is wild fishery
- About 20% of sushi tuna is raised on a "bluefin ranch" which is a more cost effective way of purchasing but wild caught bluefin are more sought after






Top Tuna Exporters
